

Introduction

This guide provides a summary of our popular and great value tickets and fares for Stagecoach services in the East of Scotland.

What's new

- Our student and U19 ticket prices have been revised, including the introduction of new student and U19 tickets valid within the Central Fife zone.
- A number of new day return tickets have been launched for an introductory period, with some prices revised.

Our range of tickets

- single tickets - designed for the occasional customer making one journey, our single fares start from £1.
- period return tickets - valid for a return trip where the return journey must be undertaken within 28 days. Not valid for 2 journeys in the same direction. Return tickets can offer around 20% saving on the price of two single tickets.
- day return tickets - valid on the day of purchase for a return trip, not valid for 2 journeys in the same direction. Unless specified, day returns are valid all day and until 0400 the following morning.
- dayrider tickets - valid for 1 day's unlimited travel within your selected zone until 0400 the following morning.
- megarider tickets - available as 7 day and 4 week options (consecutive days/weeks) for unlimited travel within your selected zone. Megarider tickets are ideal for regular travel and can be shared with friends and family when you're not using it.
- Student and U19 tickets - available as 1 day, 7 day, 4 week and 13 week options (consecutive days/weeks) for unlimited travel within your selected zone. Valid student ID/proof of age must be shown when buying/using these tickets.
- megariderXtra - a ticket based on the same zone boundaries as regular megarider tickets offering unlimited travel, but instead of a one-off payment, a recurring payment means your ticket is valid for a calendar month and will be automatically added to your StagecoachSmart card to present to our driver when you board.
- flexirider tickets - ideal for someone who makes the same journey regularly (in either direction), but not every day. You can buy 12 single journeys for the price of 10 and use whenever you like within 28 days.

Tickets for under 16s

Up to 5 years

Up to 4 children under the age of 5 travel free when accompanied by a responsible passenger, provided that the children are seated in a buggy in an appropriate space on the vehicle and/or do not occupy a seat to the exclusion of a fare paying customer.

Ages 5 - 15 only

This age group qualify for a discounted fare of up to half the adult single fare, rounded up to the nearest 10p. On services in the Angus/East Perthshire area, the concession is two-thirds of the relevant adult fare.

U16s may be asked for valid photo ID showing proof of age when buying and using tickets. Failure to show ID on request means the full adult fare is payable.

We also offer U16 megarider tickets, valid for 7 days' unlimited travel for each of our ticket zones, as well as U16 dayrider tickets valid for 1 day, for certain zones.

U16s can purchase a £1 period return ticket when travelling with an adult or concession:





- from Ferrytoll P&R/Halbeath P&R to Edinburgh (off-peak only)
- from Fife to Edinburgh Airport/Glasgow Airport (valid at all times).

Tickets for under 19s

These 1 day, 7 day, 4 week and 13 week tickets are available for anyone under the age of 19 to buy. They are particularly useful for those aged 16-18 years.

Valid photo ID showing proof of age must be shown when buying and using any of these tickets.

Young Scot Card

We suggest using a Young Scot Card as proof of age. The Young Scot Card holder is also entitled to a discount of one third off all adult single fares. You can apply for a Young Scot via your school or local authority, see youngscot.org for more info.

Nightrider - £3

A nightrider ticket is valid for unlimited travel on services across Fife, Dundee, Perthshire and Angus after 7pm. Not valid for journeys across the Forth to Edinburgh, Forth Valley, Cumbernauld or Glasgow, Stirling, or north of Montrose towards Aberdeen.

Tickets for students

We offer great value bus tickets available exclusively for students. The ticket offers unlimited travel, valid all day within the boundary you've selected. Valid student photo ID must be shown when buying and using any of these tickets.

Tickets for groups

Group tickets are ideal when the family wants to travel. Group dayrider tickets offer unlimited travel on the day of purchase within the boundary you want and are valid from 0900 Monday to Friday or anytime at weekends.

A group consists of: 1 or 2 adults + 2 children, 1 adult + 3 children or 3 adults.

Tickets for over 60s and disabled people

If you are 60 and over or have a disability, and you are a resident in Scotland, you may be entitled to free bus travel, through the National Entitlement card scheme operated by the Scottish Government. Contact your local authority for details of how to apply and to view the terms, conditions and rules applying to these schemes.

Tickets on our night buses

Only single fares or nightrider tickets (within the nightrider ticket zone) are valid on our night buses, no other return, flexirider, dayrider, megarider, unirider tickets or concession passes are valid on these routes (applies to routes N55 and N99).

Travelling with dogs

There is no charge for dogs. Guide dogs and assistance dogs will be admitted at all times and other dogs at the driver's discretion.

Through fares

A dayrider/megarider/unirider ticket is usually the cheapest option for multiple single journeys, however for many trips we have a combined fare even if you need to change buses, which may work out to be more cost effective.

For example if you're travelling to Edinburgh Airport, we offer a through fare on our Express network and JET 747 route so you'll only need one ticket, even if you need to change vehicle. Ask your driver if a through fare is available.

Where to buy

From the driver - don't forget, we give change! No cash? No problem! We accept contactless card payments under £30.

- single and return tickets
- dayrider tickets
- flexirider and 12 journey tickets
- nightrider tickets
- 7 day tickets - issued on a StagecoachSmart card. There is a £1 charge for a new card issued by the driver or "top-up" your current card.

StagecoachSmart

When you buy a 7 day, 4 week or megarider Xtra ticket, it will be loaded onto a StagecoachSmart card. You can "top-up" your card by paying the driver for a new ticket, which will be valid straight away, or you can buy megarider tickets online in advance of your travel and they will be loaded onto your card in 2 days.

There is a £1 charge for a new card issued by the driver, so be smart with your card:

- Register your card to protect your tickets if your card is lost or stolen
- Reload your card by buying tickets online or on bus
- Reuse your card and remember it for every journey

There is no charge if you buy your ticket online, or top-up your existing StagecoachSmart card.

Multi-operator tickets

ABC ticket

ABC day and week tickets are available within the Dundee area, valid for use on Moffat and Williamson, Stagecoach and Xplore Dundee services.

Buy from the driver or Dundee bus station and use whenever you like across the city.

Grasshopper

A multi-operator ticket for bus travel within Aberdeenshire. Valid for use on route X7 to/from Aberdeen. Visit www.grasshopperpass.com for info.

One-Ticket

One-ticket offers you unlimited travel on most operator's services in East and Central Scotland. Simply choose the area you wish to travel within, then use any bus routes within your zone. One-ticket offers a bus only or a rail and bus option and you can now buy and use the bus version via an app. For more information visit www.one-ticket.co.uk.

Plusbus

Plusbus tickets can be bought alongside a train ticket, giving you unlimited bus and tram travel across most operator's services in the area. Buy plusbus tickets at your local rail station or online when purchasing a rail ticket. Find out more at www.plusbus.info.

Tickets in other areas

For local travel in Glasgow and Cumbernauld, you can also use the Cumbernauld/Glasgow zone tickets. For local travel in Aberdeenshire, you can use the Aberdeen zone tickets. See full info at stagecoachbus.com.

Other terms & conditions

Refunds for longer period tickets will be considered upon written request and surrender/cancellation of the appropriate ticket. There is a £10 administration fee for refunds of paper tickets and a £5 fee for refunds on cancelled StagecoachSmart tickets.

If your StagecoachSmart card is lost or stolen, you must notify us immediately on 0345 810 1000. Replacement cards will not be issued unless the card has been registered at stagecoachbus.com. Please refer to the full terms and conditions for online sales for tickets bought on our website.

Replacement tickets due to loss or damage may be considered for unirider or paper 4 week tickets.

All customers need to have a valid ticket or pass for their journey. Customers who fail to show this when requested will be asked to pay a standard fare charge of £30 and may face prosecution.
