

Fares and Ticket Revision in Fife from Monday 27 March 2017

From Monday 27 March 2017, there will be a fares and ticket revision affecting Stagecoach services in Fife.

Last year we managed to avoid having a full fares revision and we even reduced the cost of some longer period tickets in August 2016. This year however, as with other sectors of the economy and local government, we face a challenging economic environment from rising costs and cuts to public sector spending on buses. Overall, bus industry operating costs have been rising at a higher rate than inflation for several years. Increasing road congestion and higher car use also has an impact on the cost and scope of public transport.

After a 2 year period where most of our fares have remained the same, we've now had to revise both single and return fares, as well as our multi journey, dayrider and megarider tickets.

In order to simplify our range of tickets offered, we are also withdrawing certain zone tickets which are not well used. This also includes all 13 week and 52 week paper ticket options. Other longer period tickets are available on StagecoachSmart cards, valid for 7 days, 4 weeks or monthly tickets, which are paid with a recurring payment each month.

Full details of the changes to our fares and tickets are included below and overleaf.

(Please note that Stagecoach West Scotland will have a fares revision on 3 April 2017, with fares and tickets between Cumbernauld and Glasgow revised, see separate publicity on stagecoachbus.com for more info.)

Single Fares

Most customers will see their single/return fares increase by around 3%.

To check the single fare for your journey, use the journey planner on our website at stagecoachbus.com, planning a journey on or after Monday 27 March to view the new fare.

Child fares will change in line with the adult fares and are generally half the adult fare rounded up to the 10p.

Return Fares

Return fares are based on the adult single fares above and are available for the majority of journeys.

Return fares generally offer a saving of around 10% on the price of two single fares.

Day return fares are also offered for certain journeys, providing even greater savings.

Day returns

Off-peak day returns are valid after 9am Monday to Friday, all day at the weekends & public holidays.

Other day returns may also be available which are valid at all times. New ticket prices are shown below.

Multi-journey tickets

Flexirider tickets

flexirider tickets offer 12 adult single journeys for the price of 10, and are available for any journeys on Stagecoach in Fife services. The ticket must be used within 28 days. Prices are based on the single fare and therefore the cost of a **flexirider** ticket will increase in line with single fare changes.

Edinburgh 12 journey ticket £33

This ticket offers 12 single journeys valid wholly on routes X51 and 747; service X54 between Cowdenbeath and Edinburgh; services X58/X60 between Dalgety Bay and Edinburgh and on services X55/X59 between Halbeath P&R and Edinburgh. The ticket may also be used on connecting services between Dunfermline and Ferrytoll or Halbeath Park and Ride sites. Please note that customers who use connecting services requiring a change will need a transfer ticket to carry out this journey and should request one when purchasing their ticket from the driver.

Unirider tickets

Our **unirider** tickets, available exclusively for students, are normally revised around September and will not change at this time.
