

Cash fares

Our cash fares are ideal if you're making one or two trips in and around the City.

Please note our buses have an EXACT FARE POLICY and the driver cannot give change. This keeps our drivers safe and speeds up your journey as our buses spend less time at each bus stop.

Your fare is calculated by the number of fare stages that your journey will take you through.

If you're not sure of the fare for your journey, ask your driver.

Insert the right money into the red fare box, collect your ticket from the machine beside the driver and keep it throughout your journey as an inspector may want to check it.

Children under 5

Up to three children under 5 years of age can travel free when accompanied by an adult.

Senior Citizen, Blind and Disabled travellers

Anyone aged 60 or over and many people with disabilities living in Scotland can now travel free with a Scottish Citizens' National Entitlement Card, thanks to a new scheme set up by Transport Scotland; the Scottish Executive's transport agency.

The new scheme, removes boundary restrictions and the time limits on travelling at peak periods, of the old local schemes. This means older and disabled people can now travel free on any local bus service, or scheduled long distance coach service, anywhere in Scotland even during the rush hour.

Money off public transport for 16 - 18 year olds'

The Scottish-wide concessionary Travel Scheme for Young Persons provides 1/3 off bus and rail travel for all 16 -18 year olds and young full-time volunteers.

You become eligible on your 16th birthday and fall outside the scheme on your 19th birthday. You must also be a resident in Scotland.

Journey Tickets

These tickets are National Express Dundee's most flexible way to pre-pay for your travel.

The driver will deduct your current journey by way of punching a hole in your ticket.

The driver will then return the ticket to you.
