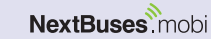

VICTORIA HOSPITAL - KIRKCALDY

General Location

Victoria Hospital is situated north of the town centre, on Hayfield Road and Dunnikier Road.

Hospital Buses / Bus Stops

• **Stop Name: Victoria Hospital - Stop Code: 34326728**

The bus stop adjacent to the Hayfield Road Entrance, on Hayfield Road, is 70 metres from this entrance and has shelter facilities with timetable information. Buses from this stop are:

6 6A 6B 13 X27 33 37 39 39A 41 X42

All Serve Kirkcaldy Railway Station and Kirkcaldy Bus Station.

• **Stop Name: Victoria Hospital - Stop Code: 34326735**

The bus stop opposite the Hayfield Road Entrance is 75 metres from this entrance and has shelter facilities with timetable information. Buses from this stop are:

6 6A 6B 13 X33 33 37 39 39A 41 X42

• **Stop Name: Hayfield Clinic - Stop Code: 34326568**

The bus stop in Dunnikier Road, opposite Edward Street, is 200 metres from the Main Hospital Entrance. Buses from this stop serve Kirkcaldy Bus Station and Railway Station:

6 6A 6B 32 33 34 34A 37 39 39A 41 108

• **Stop Name: Hayfield Cemetery - Stop Code: 34326724**

The bus stop opposite Hayfield Cemetery, on Hayfield Road, is 350 metres from the Main Entrance. Buses from this stop are:

Trains / Railway Stations

Kirkcaldy Railway Station is 1 mile south-west of the hospital. Trains run on the Edinburgh to Aberdeen line, Edinburgh to Perth line and the Fife Circle line.

Buses linking the hospital and station are:

6 6A 6B 13 32 33 34 34A 37 39 39A 41 108

The station is a PlusBus station (see overleaf) allowing you to buy a through ticket to use on the train and the bus. Ask for a 'Kirkcaldy PlusBus' ticket when you buy your train ticket.

The nearest bus stops to the station are 100 metres away, on Bennoch Road, at the end of Station Road (adjacent to Platform 1 Car Park). They have lit shelters and full timetable information. Footways and dropped kerbs allow easy access to the stops from Platform 1. The bus stops can be accessed from Platform 2 via a lift and a subway which will bring you out at the Platform 1 car park. For more information on the railway station facilities, pick up a copy of the Fife Access Guide (see overleaf).

Travel Information

There are bus and train timetables in the leaflet carousel located in the Hospital's main reception area and at Bus Stations, Council Local Services Centres and Tourist Information Centres in Fife. Contact phone and internet details are shown overleaf.

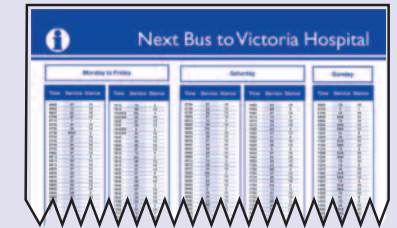

The combined frequency of buses to the hospital is every 5-10 minutes (Mon - Sat, daytime) / every 30 minutes (evenings & Sunday). Each stance at the Bus Station has shelters, timetable and route information and departure screens. The Supervisor's Office and Travel Shop are in the main building (between Stances 6 and 7). 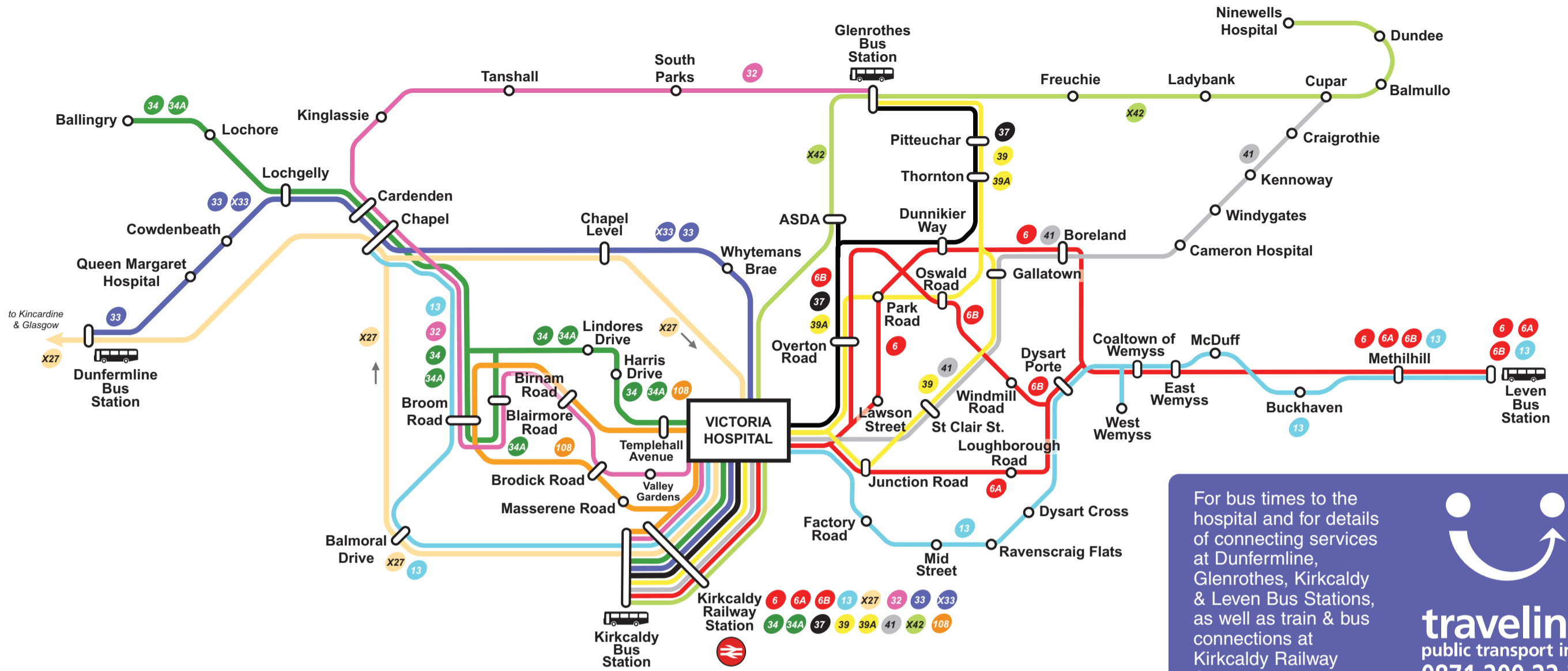
